UPDATE - Preventing and Addressing Workplace Harassment Training

ALCOAST 170/19 was released in May and required all members of the Coast Guard, including CG reservists, to complete the DHS mandated 'Preventing and Addressing Workplace Harassment Training' training by 15 July 2019.

As of 30 July, the CG Reserve had a completion rate of approximately 85%.

It is imperative you complete this requirement ASAP. You can access the course by logging into the Learning Management System (LMS) and finding course catalog #100227. Please use the below link to access LMS.

1. The Department of Homeland Security (DHS) has mandated "Preventing and Addressing Workplace Harassment Training" for members of all DHS components to be completed by July 15, 2019.
